Collection Description

Biographical Note:

The Department of Research and Survey was founded as a partnership between the Chicago Theological Seminary (CTS) and the Chicago Congregational Missionary and Extension Society (CCMES; later the Chicago Congregational Union, and then the Community Renewal Society). It was first described in 1927 by Reverend Ernest G. Guthrie, Director of the CCMES. Writing to Arthur E. Holt, professor of Social Ethics at the CTS, Guthrie proposed that the Department “be established first, for and by our Congregational churches; second, for the entire group of Protestant churches and ultimately as an approved instrument for the advance of the church in all the great cities of the land” (Register, 1927).

What the Department ultimately developed into was more akin to a “social laboratory” (McGiffert,

1965). Holt soon brought Samuel C. Kincheloe on to help lead the Department. Teaching together, Holt and Kincheloe instructed students in applying the social sciences to studying how churches related to their communities. Students conducted a variety of surveys, censuses, and other research projects across Chicago. Their work focused most often on churches that were somehow struggling. Through their research, students would present the churches with several different plans for moving forward.

Victor Obenhaus would eventually join Kincheloe in running the Department after Holt's death in 1942. Kincheloe left CTS in 1956 to become president of Tougaloo College. The Department's activities eventually ceased sometime in the late 1960s or early 1970s.

Abstract: Chicago's Japanese population went from around 400 before WWII, to over 20,000 by 1946–1947. This increase was a result of the War Relocation Authority (WRA), the agency charged with overseeing the camps where the federal government had forcibly confined some 110,000 Japanese-Americans beginning in 1942. As a way to both encourage assimilation and to ensure that the imprisoned population did not become too dependent on the government for survival, the WRA began offering those who passed a "loyalty questionnaire" the chance to relocate to locations across the Midwest.

The WRA moved around 6,600 people from the camps to Chicago. Numerous religious organizations, including the Chicago Church Federation's United Ministry to Resettlers, helped these "resettlers" with things such as housing, employment, and other aspects of community building.

There is also a copy of Rev. Gordon J. Baker's 2009 manuscript, "The Churches and the Japanese Evacuation of World War II," which contains copies of newspaper clippings, correspondence, and interviews pertaining to internment and relocation.

The number of Filipinos in Chicago remained relatively low as a result, with population estimates remaining below 5,000 people until the late 1960s.
